time really does fly: three months have passed since our last newsletter. We've had an eventful few weeks, with lots of encounters and news, which we'd like to share with you in this issue.



Thanks to several generous donations, we have been able to fulfil the dream of a safe home for six families in particular need in the past three months alone. A huge thank you to the donors! We were able to see for ourselves just how important and sustainable our Khublei **house-building project** is during our visit to Meghalaya.



Nida from Pasyih had previously been living with her husband and four children in extremely cramped conditions in a dilapidated hut with a leaky tin roof and thin tin walls, with no private space and no shelter from the wind and rain.



The family now lives in a sturdy brick house. Insecurity has given way to a sense of security and hope; a makeshift shelter has become a proper home.

For Nida and her family, this means a roof over their heads and the chance of a safe and dignified life.



What an unforgettable day for some of the children at the **school for the blind in Nongbah**! Full of anticipation, a good dose of stage fright and the musical instruments funded by Khublei, they set off by bus for their first big performance.



The occasion was a very special one: the wedding of their dedicated volunteer music teacher, Rosario, and his wife, Weimanhi. With great heart, enthusiasm and palpable gratitude, the children enriched the celebration with their music and gave the bride and groom, as well as the guests, a moving moment that no one will forget in a hurry.
